Teaching

My teaching experience amounts to around 6000 hours or the equivalent of 3.5 years full-time teaching, spread out between the spring semester of 2010 and the spring semester of 2021. It includes teaching on all levels on the Bachelor’s Programme in Rhetorical Studies at Södertörn University. Among other things, I developed and taught the courses *Barbara Cassin – Politics, Sophistics, Rhetoric* and *The Rhetoric of Populism*. I have also been teaching on free-standing courses in argumentation, political rhetoric, and rhetorical criticism, and courses in public speaking for students on a variety of different educational programmes (e.g., Business Administration, Teacher Education, Environmental Science) at Södertörn University. On the post-graduate level, I have taught on the Master’s Programme in Environmental Science, Södertörn University, the Master’s Programme in Rhetoric at Uppsala University, and on the Master’s level at BI Norwegian Business School.
